Elsewhere, Derrida calls *différance* an "arche-writing" (from the Greek *arche*, meaning "beginning" or "origin", French: *archi-écriture*), the condition of non-self-presence from which both speech and writing are derived. Arche-writing is not the same as writing as opposed to speech, and *différance* is not the same as difference as opposed to identity; arche-writing is the condition of possibility both of speech and writing (in other words it makes them both possible in the first ...

Explaining Derrida with Diagrams 1: Différance ...

A concept introduced by Derrida, *différance* is a pun on "difference" and "deferment", and is that attribute of language, by which meaning is generated because of a word's difference from other words in a signifying system, and at the same time, meaning is inevitably and infinitely deferred or postponed, is constantly under erasure and can be glimpsed only through "aporias" or deadlocks in understanding.

Derrida's Concept of Différance | Literary Theory and ...

The arche-writing that Derrida is talking about is in fact a broader notion of writing conceptualized in terms of *différance*. This *différance* (the *a* is a trace, a gram) as temporalization is the trace [track] of the written language in the spoken. For instance, punctuation signs are supplemental to speech, not a reproduction of it.
